Statement by König u. Meyer GmbH u. Co. KG regarding "California Proposition 65"

The "California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act" of 1986, also known as California Proposition 65 or CP65, is intended to safe the drinking water sources of California.

The key message of this law is that no one in the course of their business, whether knowingly or unknowingly, may expose other people to a chemical that, according to current knowledge, can cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, without first providing consumers with clear and adequate information on this risk.

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) has published a list that now contains about 1000 potentially hazardous substances. (according to the current status March, 2020)

CP65 requires consumers to be warned of possible exposure to a hazardous substance as soon as they can have contact with it.

The listed substances carbon black (airborne, unbound particles of respirable size), styrene and titanium dioxide (airborne, unbound particles of respirable size) are contained in raw materials of our products. These materials are used, because there are no known alternatives that meet our requirements.

When used as intended, the consumer of our products is not exposed to disproportionate exposure to hazardous substances. Our products are generally not intended to be used for drinking water applications.
